



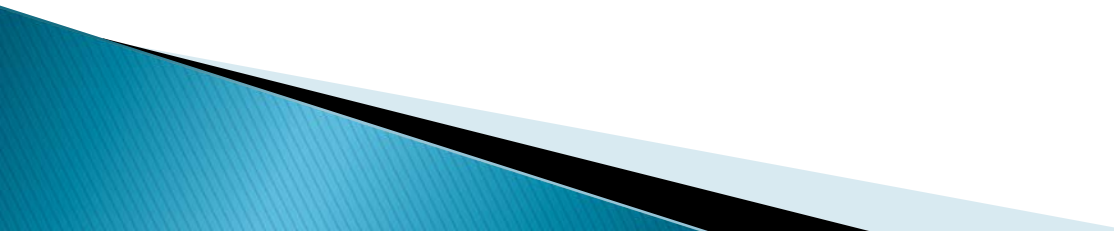



▶ **Full/Active Membership:**

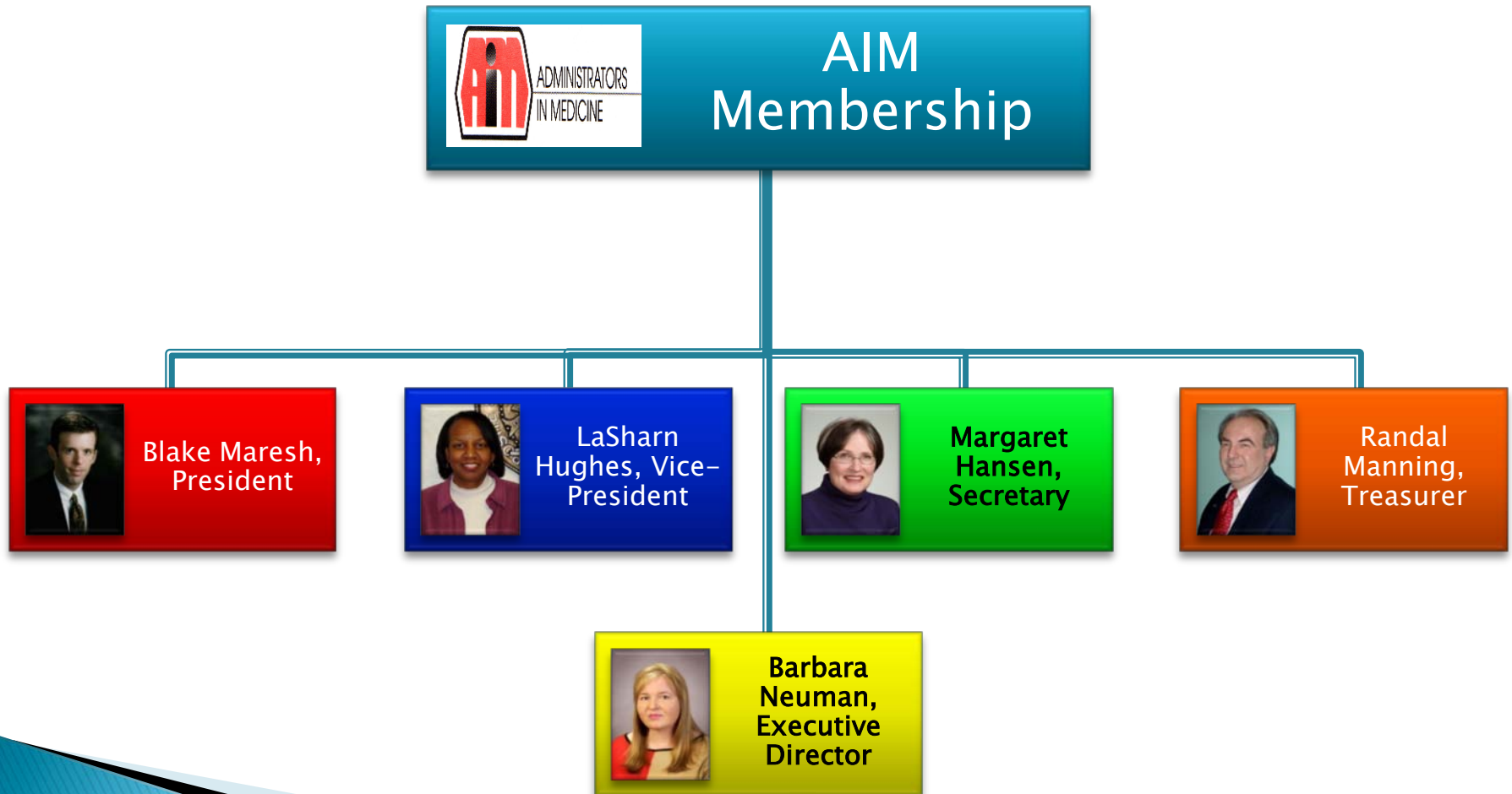
- Administrators in agencies responsible for licensure and/or discipline of physicians

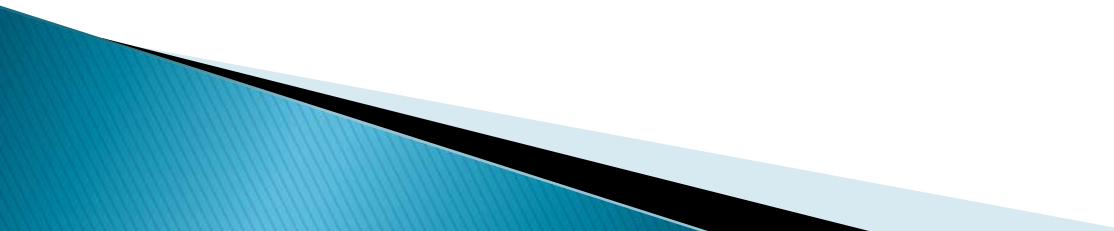

 - ▶ JAFEI – Joint AIM/FSMB Executive Institute
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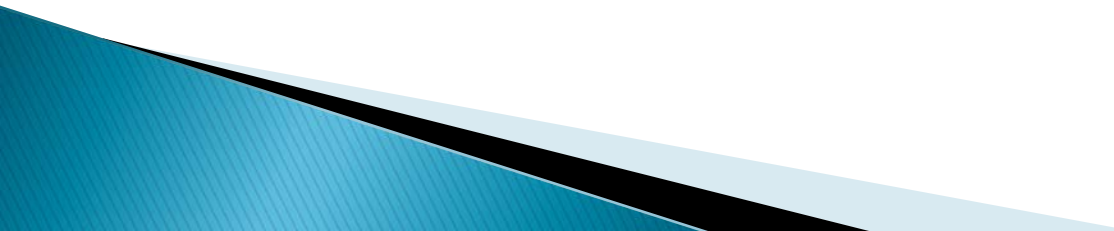

DocFinder

- ▶ Founded in 1996 – 15th anniversary this year.
 - ▶ Nationally-recognized online search engine of board licensees
 - ▶ Nearly a quarter-billion searches
 - ▶ Provides web links to board web sites
- 

VeriDoc

- ▶ A centralized license verification system for medical & osteopathic boards.
- ▶ Physicians contact VeriDoc and, for one fee, have their state licenses verified for a new state license application.
- ▶ State receives the fee, less \$10 to VeriDoc
- ▶ AIM gets the benefit of \$1 per transaction.

ExecNet

- ▶ An electronic bulletin board service provided to full AIM Members.
- ▶ Board executives can put out a “call for assistance” to others across the country:
 - Legislative
 - Licensing
 - Discipline
 - Technology
 - Board administration
- ▶ Responses are automatically compiled in one place

AIMAP

- ▶ Administrators in Medicine Assessment Program
- ▶ A structured evaluation of board's operations (in whole or part) using:
 - Talent and insight of AIM membership, and
 - FSMB guiding documents *Essentials of a Modern Medical and Osteopathic Practice Act* and *Elements of a Modern State Medical and Osteopathic Board*
- ▶ Demonstrates “good faith” to legislature, media.
- ▶ Projects include Maine MD and Nevada MD

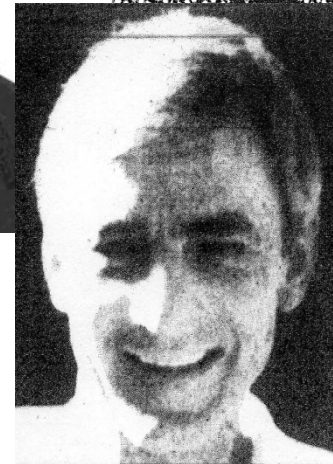
Best of Boards Awards
