On May 5, 1999, you applied for renewal of your Maine medical license, and on March 11, 2003, the Board voted to preliminarily deny that application. This action taken by the Maine medical board is based on incompetence in the practice for which you, the licensee, are licensed.

You were notified of the above action by letter dated March 19, 2003, which was sent certified mail with a return receipt requested to your Lewiston address as well as a copy to your Lewiston address. The letter was received and signed for at a Rhode Island address. You did not appeal the Board's action and, therefore, the denial became final, effective April 24, 2003. The Maine sanction will be reported to the appropriate data banks.
