It has come to the attention of the Board of Registration in Medicine that you are or recently have been a patient in a detoxication program, that you have improperly utilized your prescription writing privileges, and that your ability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety may be impaired.

In view of your failure to follow the Board's directive that you adhere to an after-care program and refrain from any alcohol or drug intake, as outlined in the Board's letter to you dated August 26, 1981, the Board, at its meeting on July 12 voted to request that you voluntarily surrender to the Board of Registration in Medicine your license to practice medicine in the State of Maine.

You may do this by signing and returning this letter and your 1982-84 certificate of registration to the Board office within ten days. A return envelope is enclosed for your convenience.

Failure to do so may result in the Board's taking formal action to revoke or suspend your license pursuant to 32 MRSA, Section 3283.

The Board will consider a voluntary surrender to be a legal suspension of your license. The result of such a suspension is that you will not be permitted to practice medicine in Maine until you have shown to the Board's satisfaction that you have been rehabilitated and that you are competent to reenter the practice of medicine.

Your signature on this letter will serve as a memorial of agreement between you and the Board that if you voluntarily surrender your license and you do not attempt to practice medicine until your license has been reinstated, the Board will not take formal legal action against you.

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At reasonable intervals and upon the recommendation of a physician specialist in substance abuse you will be afforded an opportunity to demonstrate that you are able to resume the practice of medicine with reasonable skill and safety.
