I am writing to you in response to the above complaint letter dated November 16, 2006, a complaint filed against my Maine medical license.

I hereby notify the Board that I have retired from the practice of medicine. Therefore, in lieu of further proceedings with regard to the above complaint, I hereby tender to the Board the surrender of my Maine medical license. I understand that, should the Board vote to accept my surrender of licensure, the Board-initiated complaint will be dismissed. I further understand that, since I am surrendering my license while under investigation, that the Board will file a report with the National Practitioner Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards data bank that I surrendered my Maine medical license while under investigation of a pending complaint.

Finally, I understand that, should the Board accept the surrender of my Maine medical license, the Board will take no further action against my license not listed herein, but that the Board might subpoena me to be a witness in other matters involving other practitioners.
