

of Medicine which became a Final Board Order in June, 1995. Dr. Helmy accepted a Letter of Concern, a \$3,000 fine and agreed to do 50 CME hours in pediatric orthopaedics. When he applied for renewal of his Maine medical license in September, 1996, Dr. Helmy did not disclose that fact that he had been disciplined by the Florida Board of Medicine.

In January, 1997 the Board of Licensure in Medicine issued a complaint against Dr. Helmy based on allegations of fraud and deceit in obtaining his license in 1994 and 1996. Dr. Helmy denies the factual allegations which are the basis of this complaint and maintains that the omissions were inadvertent and not intentional.

The factual basis for discipline by the Florida Board of Medical Examiners constitutes grounds for discipline by the Board according to 32 M.R.S.A. § 3282-A. The findings and orders of the Florida Board of Medical Examiners are incorporated in this Consent Agreement and copies are attached

AGREEMENT

In lieu of proceeding to an adjudicatory hearing on the complaint, Dr. Helmy agrees to the following:


1. The Board has jurisdiction over Dr. Helmy and over the disciplinary matters raised by the complaint issued by the Board in January, 1997.
2. Dr. Helmy agrees to voluntarily surrender his Maine medical license as of the date of this agreement. Dr. Helmy will not seek to renew his license to practice medicine in Maine and he will not be relicensed to practice medicine by the Board of Licensure in Medicine for the State of Maine or its successor.
3. Dr. Helmy agrees to waive his right to a hearing before the Board or

any court regarding all terms and conditions of this Consent Agreement.


4. Dr. Helmy has been advised of his right to seek legal counsel with respect to the terms of this agreement.

I, Maher H. Helmy, M.D., have read and understand the foregoing Consent Agreement. I understand that by signing it, I waive certain rights. I sign it voluntarily, without any threat or promise. I understand this Consent Agreement contains the entire agreement and there is no other agreement of any kind.


