In Dr. Hugo' s application to renew his registration to practice medicine in the State of Maine for the period July 1, 1992 through June 30, 1994, he again failed to report when questioned that he had been disciplined by the State Board of Medical Examiners in New Jersey by virtue of the Consent Agreement entered into on March 23, 1990.

In Dr. Hugo' s application to renew his registration to practice medicine in the State of Maine for the period July 1, 1994 through June 30, 1996, he again failed to report, when questioned, that he had been disciplined by the State Board of Medical Examiners in New Jersey by virtue of the Consent Agreement entered into on March 23, 1990.

#### LICENSE MODIFICATIONS

1. Title 32 M.R.S.A. §3282-A (2) (E) and 10 M.R.S.A. § 8003 (5) authorizes the Board of Registration in Medicine to take disciplinary action against a licensee for "Incompetence in the practice for which he is licensed." Dr. Hugo agrees to accept a reprimand for the conduct which formed the basis of the disciplinary action taken by the State Board of Medical Examiners in New Jersey on March 23, 1990.

2. Dr. Hugo agrees that if at the time he begins to practice medicine in Maine, he has had a complaint filed or discipline imposed against him with respect to his follow-up on patients for whom he has assumed care within the preceding five years, his license shall, at a minimum, be modified to provide for monitoring of his follow-up care by a physician and in a manner to be approved by the Board.

By agreeing to this paragraph, the Board reserves the authority to take greater disciplinary action against Dr. Hugo with respect to allegations not referred to in the Consent Agreement entered into with the State of New Jersey, referred to in paragraph 2 of the Statement of Facts, should they arise.

3. Dr. Hugo agrees not to practice medicine in Maine until he has received confirmation by the Board that no complaints or discipline have been imposed against him within the preceding five years, or in the alternative, a monitoring system and monitoring physician referred to in the preceding paragraph has been approved by the Board.

4. Title 32 M.R.S.A. §3282-A (2)(A) and 10 M.R.S.A. §8003 (5) authorizes the Board of Registration in Medicine to take disciplinary action against a licensee for "the practice of fraud or deceit in obtaining a license under this chapter...." Dr. Hugo agrees to accept a reprimand and to pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,500 for a violation of these provisions with respect to the facts set forth in paragraphs 3, 4 and 5 of the Statement of Facts.


5. Any modification of this Consent Agreement must be in writing and signed by all parties.
