



1. The Licensee agrees to voluntarily surrender his license to practice medicine in the State of Maine.

2. The voluntary surrender shall remain in effect until final resolution of the criminal matters pending against the Licensee in the State of Massachusetts.

3. The voluntary surrender does not prevent the Board from pursuing disciplinary action against the Licensee and, if appropriate, imposing disciplinary sanctions.

4. The Licensee has carefully considered his decision and is aware of the consequences of this decision.

5. The Licensee waives his right to a hearing before the Board or in a court or in any court regarding all findings, terms and conditions of this agreement.

6. The Licensee is aware of his right to be represented by counsel.

I, JAMES P. KARTELL, M.D., HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE FOREGOING CONSENT AGREEMENT. I UNDERSTAND THAT BY SIGNING IT, I WAIVE CERTAIN RIGHTS. I SIGN THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT VOLUNTARILY, WITHOUT ANY THREAT OR PROMISE. I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT CONTAINS THE ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND THERE IS NO OTHER AGREEMENT OF ANY KIND, VERBAL, WRITTEN OR OTHERWISE.
