

6. The review showed that the improper medical practices associated with the Licensee's care and treatment of Patient A were isolated and not part of a pattern of practice.

AGREEMENT

In lieu of proceeding to an adjudicatory hearing, the Licensee agrees to the following:

1. The foregoing findings of fact constitute unprofessional conduct as defined by 32 M.R.S.A. § 3282-A(2)(F) and are contrary to the standards of professional behavior established in the practice of medicine.
2. The Licensee agrees to accept a **WARNING** and to pay a fine of \$1,500.00 as discipline.
3. If the Board receives verified information that the Licensee has engaged in the unlawful practice of selling drug samples, the Licensee agrees to the automatic suspension of his license.
4. The Licensee will not supervise physician assistants as part of his medical practice.
5. The Licensee waives his right to a hearing before the Board or any court regarding all terms and conditions of this Consent Agreement.
