

against Dr. Reyes with respect to allegations not referred to in the Consent Agreement entered into with the State of New Jersey, referred to in paragraph 2 of the Statement of Facts, should they arise.

2. Dr. Reyes agrees not to practice medicine in Maine until she has received confirmation by the Board that no complaints or discipline have been imposed against her within the preceding five years, or in the alternative, a monitoring system and monitoring physician referred to in the preceding paragraph has been approved by the Board.


3. Any modification of this Consent Agreement must be in writing and signed by all parties.

4. Dr. Reyes has had the opportunity to seek advice of counsel with respect to the negotiation of this Consent Agreement.


