ADMINISTRATIVE CONSENT AGREEMENT

On Tuesday, January 11, 1983, the Maine State Board of Registration in Medicine (hereinafter "the Board") conducted an adjudicatory hearing to determine whether grounds exist to take disciplinary action against Norman M. Rosenbaum, M.D. Dr. Rosenbaum acknowledged that he has had a problem involving the use of drugs. In addition, Dr. Rosenbaum and his treating psychiatrist, Dr. Richard Evans, testified that Dr. Rosenbaum suffers from a personality disorder diagnosed as manic depressive, manic type. Dr. Evans further testified that in his opinion Dr. Rosenbaum's abuse of drugs is related to the manic depressive disorder and that as a result of the manic depressive disorder Dr. Rosenbaum will continue to be at risk of abusing drugs for a lengthy period of time. Because of Dr. Rosenbaum's admissions regarding his drug related problem and his willingness to seek therapy to overcome his psychiatric problems and to control his drug problem, and because the Board is satisfied that Dr. Rosenbaum's practice of medicine does not pose a threat to the health and safety of the public provided he adheres to the conditions imposed upon his license to practice by this agreement, the Board wishes to resolve this matter without filing an action in Administrative Court. Therefore, Dr. Rosenbaum and the Board hereby agree to the terms of the following consent agreement:

- (1) The Board agrees to renew Dr. Rosenbaum's license to practice medicine in this state under a probationary status for a period of ten (10) years from the date of renewal of his license;
- (2) The parties agree that during said probationary period Dr. Rosenbaum shall not practice as an anesthesiologist in this state on either a full or part-time basis, except that Dr. Rosenbaum may provide local and topical anesthesia to patients

in his office to the extent that such services are incidental to other medical services rendered to such patients;

- (3) During the probationary period, Dr. Rosenbaum agrees to continue his out-patient psychotherapy on a regular basis with a psychiatrist approved by the Board and licensed to practice medicine in this state;
- (4) During this probationary period, Dr. Rosenbaum agrees to make arrangements with his employer or other appropriate person(s) to administer unscheduled urine tests to determine Dr. Rosenbaum's abstinence from scheduled drug abuse and to have the results of such tests submitted to the Board. The Board reserves the right to approve or direct the frequency of the unscheduled urine tests.

It is understood that if for any reason Dr. Rosenbaum fails to fulfill any of his obligations under this agreement, the Board will be released from all its obligations under this agreement and will be free to take whatever action it deems appropriate. Specifically, upon evidence that Dr. Rosenbaum has failed to remain drug free, the Board may request the Attorney General's Office to file an action in Administrative Court to revoke, suspend or nonrenew Dr. Rosenbaum's license to practice medicine on the basis of his drug abuse.

This Administrative Consent Agreement may be amended only by agreement of the parties.
