This Consent Agreement is entered into between Virgil G. Wright, M.D., the State of Maine Board of Licensure in Medicine ("the Board") and the State of Maine Department of Attorney General. This Consent Agreement is issued pursuant to 10 M.R.S.A. § 8003(5)(B) and 32 M.R.S.A. § 3282-A.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Dr. Wright has been licensed to practice medicine in the State of Maine since 1966. He has practiced medicine out of state and has not practiced in the State of Maine since 1967. Dr. Wright is currently licensed to practice medicine in the State of Washington.

At the time of his most recent application for renewal in June, 1994, Dr. Wright resided in Bermuda and he continues to reside there. When he completed his application for renewal in 1994, Dr. Wright stated that he had retired. He failed to adequately disclose that disciplinary action had been taken against him by the State of Washington since the time of his last application for renewal in 1992. Dr. Wright had been the subject of an investigation by the Medical Disciplinary Board of the State of Washington since 1991. That fact was not adequately disclosed by Dr. Wright in his applications for renewal to the Board in 1992. On February 28,

1994, Dr. Wright signed a Stipulation and Order of the Medical Disciplinary Board of the State of Washington which suspended his license for five years. He also did not adequately disclose these disciplinary actions taken by the Medical Disciplinary Board of the State of Washington to the Maine Board of Licensure in Medicine when he signed his application for renewal of his license in Maine on June 6, 1994. On November 8, 1994, the Board issued a complaint against Dr. Wright under 32 M.R.S.A. § 3282-A(2)(A). The Board voted to proceed to an adjudicatory hearing, which was scheduled for August 9, 1995.

#### AGREEMENT

In lieu of proceeding to an adjudicatory hearing, Dr. Wright agrees to the following:

1. The Board has grounds to impose discipline pursuant to 32 M.R.S.A. § 3282-A(2)(A) and (C). Dr. Wright denies that he ever intended to commit fraud or to deceive the Board when he filed his applications for renewal in 1992 and 1994. He admits that he has a mental or physical condition that has resulted or may result in his performing services in a manner that endangers the health or safety of patients.
2. Dr. Wright's license to practice medicine in the State of Maine will not be renewed and his license shall be deemed to have been permanently surrendered as of the date of this Agreement. Dr. Wright will not be relicensed to practice in the State of Maine by the Board or its successor.
3. Dr. Wright waives his right to a hearing before the Board or any court regarding all terms and conditions of this Consent Agreement.

4. Dr. Wright has been advised by counsel with respect to the terms of this Agreement.


I, Virgil G. Wright, M.D., have read and understand the foregoing Consent Agreement. I understand that by signing it, I waive certain rights. I sign it voluntarily, without any threat or promise. I understand this Consent Agreement contains the entire agreement, and there is no other agreement of any kind.


